À LA RECHERCHE DU TEMPS PERDU

Suite à l'invitation qu'il a reçu de participer à l'exposition Jusqu'à ce que la mort nous sépare, l'artiste Steven Renald a eu envie de créer un vêtement de papier personnel qui lui irait comme un gant. Il se trompait...

Il voyait cet habit plutôt androgyn et présenté dans une position dynamique courant vers un idéal impossible. Il l'imaginait flotter dans une installation de lacets enchevêtrés, qui comme l'amour, nous soulèvent et nous retiennent. Après une suite d'essais et d'erreurs, Steven a réalisé avec satisfaction que ce vêtement n'irait ni à un homme ni à une femme. Il lui vint l'idée de faire participer ses correspondants d'art postal à ce projet. Il leur a donc proposé de lui faire La grande demande "afin d'inspirer la personne que j'aime". Soixantequinze d'entre eux ont répondu à son appel et ont demandé l'artiste en mariage. Il avait promis une réponse à ces lettres touchantes et originales qui se trouvent maintenant sur la traîne double de cette robe-smoking moulée sur l'être cher.

Par hasard, durant cette production, il fréquentait Proust, *À la recherche du temps perdu*. Une amie les a présentés. Après s'être plongé dans cette œuvre et perdu à son goût, il a encerclé un mot sur chacune des 2 401 pages: mots qui lui rappelaient un divorce passé qui croyait oublié. L'exercice s'est avéré douloureux et libérateur en même temps. Concrètement, les pages de ce roman touffu sont devenues la doublure de cette nouvelle robe et de son ancien inconfort. La personne que Steven Renald aime fut inspirée à la lecture des lettres d'amour qu'il recevait de ses correspondants. Par une seule phrase, son amour a décidé de répondre, à la place de l'artiste, aux nombreuses demandes qui lui ont été adressées.

L'exposition se tient au Centre d'exposition Raymond-Lasnier à Trois-Rivières, du 12 septembre au 17 octobre 2010.

launch of new ReSite- Manual of Scores, Manifestos and Radical Actions

ReSite magazine, published by Field Study, will be re-launched with a new format and philosophy of intent. ReSite will no longer be a loose-leaf publication, but instead will take the form of a wire bound manual. ReSite will remain an assembling publication where all pages are to be conceived as having an element of audience participation or interaction. Works can take the form of scores, instructions or interventions, to be realised by the reader.

ReSite is part of the tradition of Fluxus editions where anyone can perform a Fluxus action or score. In addition to the concept brief, future participants should think about their works in a more critical way and tap into the rich tradition of the avant-grade. ReSite will become a manual reflecting the diversity of current alternative practice. Hopefully this will encourage writers and musicians to produce visual scores as well as continuing contributions by conceptual artists.





ABOUT THE ENVELOPES

Each is an original work. Number 24/35, indicates this envelope is the 24th of the 35 envelopes laid out on my work table. These are overlaid with various objects that create the patterns when sprayed with coloured inks; generally two colours per "edition." When dry, they are signed and numbered. Four such "editions" are created to carry an issue of the **Banana Rag**.

When I began recycling envelopes this way, I didn't number the editions, but I'm guessing they go back to **BR** 32 of July 2002. That's eight issues of the **Banana Rag** x 4 editions of envelopes per issue = 32 envelope editions; each with 30-48 envelopes per edition (depending on sizes of envelopes) = 1,280 unique envelopes in circulation since 2002.

In the late 1970's Cavellin started **Operation Round Trip**, reworking the envelopes in which he received network art, then sending them back to the original sender. Given that I'm mailing 150+ copies/issue, I haven't tried to match envelopes to original sender, but I'm doing so with some copies of this issue, so look for your original return address markings under the inks. Yours might be one of the ones I'm able to match up... an old mail-art game revived. Happy hunting! *AnnaB.Nana*
