Juror: TONI ONLEY

Toni Onley was born on the Isle of Man. He studied at the Douglas School of Fine Arts, Great Britain, under John Nicolson, and attended the Doon School of Fine Arts, under Carl Schafer. He moved to Canada in 1948. In 1957 he was awarded a scholarship to study fresco techniques with James Pinto at the Institute Allende in Mexico. In 1961 and 1963, he was awarded Canada Council Fellowships to work in England. In 1961 he completed a large mural for Queen Elizabath Playhouse in Vancouver. He was elected an associate of the Royal Canadian Academy in 1964. He has exhibited extensively in one-man shows in North American and in group shows internationally. His works are in private and public collections in Vancouver, Victoria, Ottawa, Toronto, Montreal, New York, Seattle, and London, England. He is presently living in Vancouver and is teaching at the University of B.C.






